GUIDELINES

Purpose: To assist young men and women of the Crozet/White Hall area in securing formal training beyond high school.

Who may apply for a grant? Any high school senior or graduate (or equivalent) living in the Crozet/White Hall area who plans to attend college/technical school within one year of application for this scholarship. Applications may be made for one or both of the available scholarship grants.

How are recipients of grants determined? The White Hall Ruritan Education Committee and Executive Board will determine the recipients based on financial need, character, scholarship, academic promise, community service and desire by the applicant for further education or training.

How often may a student apply? Grants are made annually. A scholarship applicant or recipient may reapply.

How is a grant disbursed? A grant is disbursed directly to the college/technical school attended by the scholarship recipient.

What is the deadline for applying? Application, school record and reference letter must be received by April 30, 2019.

How do I apply? All application forms may be downloaded from the White Hall Ruritan website: www.whitehallva.org or secured from Shelby Poole, Western Albemarle HS guidance department.

What documents are needed?

1. Application: To be completed and signed by applicant and, if applicable, parent or guardian.
2. School record: to be provided with application form.
3. One Reference letter completed by faculty member or guidance counselor.
